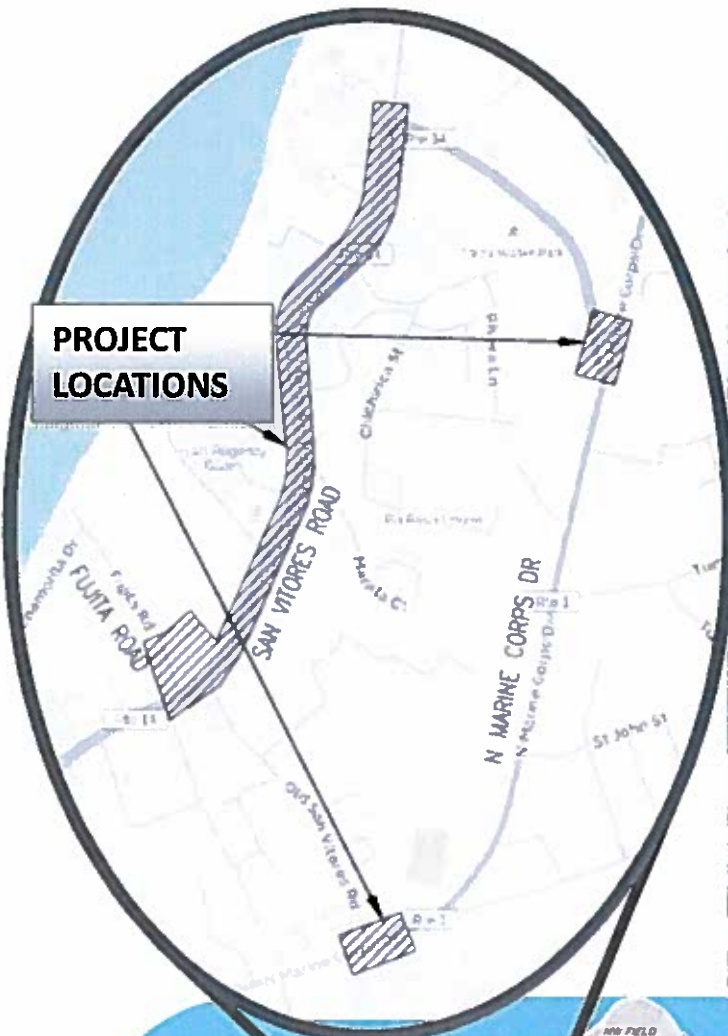

In its continuing efforts to provide advance and relevant notice, the Guam Economic Development Authority, is sending this letter to inform you that **Phase II** of the San Vitores Flood Mitigation under the HOT Bond Projects is scheduled to begin along San Vitores Road. Phase II involves the installation of additional storm water and trench drain inlets between Fujita Road and Route 14 with additional work on the intersections of Route 14 & 1 and Happy Landing (Old San Vitores) Road & Route 1 (see Attached Map). Onsite activities are scheduled to begin the week of June 19, and occur at various times and locations through November 2017. Construction will commence near the intersection of Happy Landing and San Vitores Roads. Activities will result in intermittent lane and sidewalk closures.

This project will be conducted in a manner to minimize disturbance to vehicular and pedestrian traffic to the greatest extent practical. Work at driveways or entrances will be conducted to maintain access to local businesses and streets at all times. Lane closures may occur between the hours of 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Construction is limited to encompass no more than 5 inlet locations at any one time to minimize the duration of impacts at each location. No Saturday, Sunday or federal holiday work is anticipated.

This Project is being administered through the Guam Economic Development Authority (GEDA) and is funded using HOT Bonds. Public Law 30-228 appropriated proceeds from the HOT Bond “for resolution of the San Vitores flooding caused by storm water runoff along San Vitores Road north of the Fujita Pump Station”. This project is intended to mitigate the flooding that intermittently occurs in the lower Tumon area.

This project will also involve maintenance at Fujita Pond to remove accumulated sediments and to make repairs to existing fences. Sediments were last removed from the pond during 2014, and this work is being completed to maintain its design capacity and to improve public safety.
