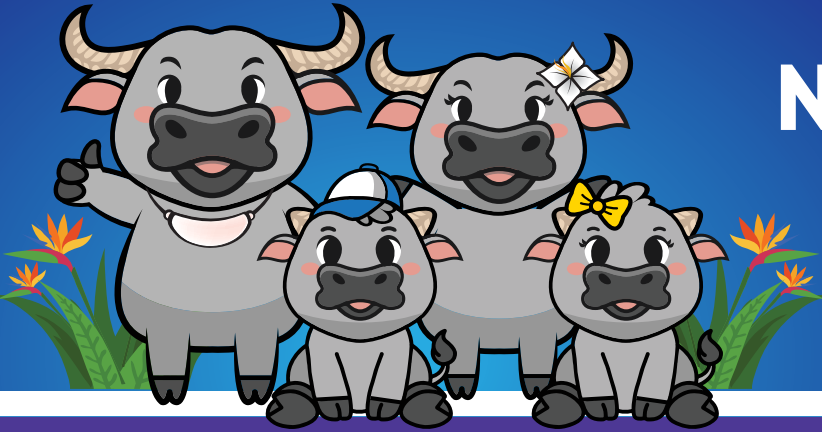

Need help paying for child care?

Great news for Guam families

Bureau of Child Care Services

Guam families can get financial support for child care through Prugrãman Pinilan.

How much support can my family get? If eligibility requirements are met, Prugrãman Pinilan can cover up to 100% of monthly child care costs (at a CCDF certified center) for families with children ages 0-13 years old.*

*Children with special needs may also be eligible up to 18 years old.



More families now eligible

With the expanded income threshold, more families are now eligible for child care financial assistance.

Income eligibility guidelines

If your household income is below these thresholds, you are eligible for this program.
